## Break free - the thrill of adventure

Break Free is run by a group of professional outdoor instructors with one goal: to bring our love of extreme sports to you! Located in the heart of the Rocky Mountains, we were recently voted the best adventure centre in Canada. (0) $\qquad$

## Sphereing

Rolling head-over-heels down a steep hill is guaranteed to give you a thrill. (1)
Sphereing! First you get inside a four-metre plastic sphere that looks like a huge transparent golf ball. Then you roll down a hill at speeds of up to fifty-five kilometres per hour! The sphere is big enough for two so you can enjoy this fantastic experience with a friend. (2) $\qquad$ Or you can roll down the hill in the dark in a blacked out sphere. Sphereing is amazing! One roll and you'll want to do it again. Two rolls and you'll be addicted! Sphereing runs from April to September and it costs $\$ 45$ per person. ## Adventure tubing

If you have ever floated on the water in an old tyre, then you have an idea of what adventure tubing is like. But it is, of course, more extreme. Adventure tubing gives you all the thrill of white-water rafting but in perfect safety. The tubes are specially reinforced to protect you as you ride the white water, dodge rocks and jump off cliffs.
